Flexible learning to suit your lifestyle

You can choose to study our postgraduate courses full-time, part-time or in some cases online, with the flexibility to manage your study around your other commitments such as work or family.

We offer a range of flexible qualifications, including:

- · entry-level graduate certificate qualifications, which can be studied as standalone awards or added to a one-year master course
- direct entry into our one-year master courses if you have a relevant bachelor degree and work experience
- entry into our graduate diploma qualifications, which can deepen your knowledge of your chosen field
- entry into our two-year master courses, if you do not have a relevant bachelor degree and relevant work experience.

Get valuable industry experience


Recognition for your work

Postgraduate degree options

There are various pathways to a postgraduate program at Curtin. Many of our courses allow you to enrol in a graduate certificate and progress through to a master degree.

Graduate certificate

Graduate certificates will help you upskill and experience postgraduate study in a short timeframe. You'll study four units (6 months full-time) and deepen your knowledge in your chosen area.

A graduate certificate is also a great stepping stone into a graduate diploma or a master degree, if you don't meet the admission criteria.

Graduate diploma

Graduate diplomas are our mid-way qualifications and are designed to help you lift knowledge in your chosen field to a higher level. You'll study eight units (1 year full-time), but you can reduce your study to four units (6 months full-time) if you've already studied a graduate certificate in the same subject.

This is the ideal middle ground if you want a more advanced qualification than a graduate certificate but don't have time for a master degree.

Master

A master degree is an advanced qualification in your chosen field. It is a great opportunity for you to build on your knowledge or switch career. There are two types of master degrees:

- A direct-entry master is a fast-tracked, advanced qualification if you have a relevant undergraduate degree and work experience. It is designed to expand your already established skills and knowledge in a chosen area. You'll study eight units (1 year full-time).
- A two-year master is an advanced degree if you do not have a relevant undergraduate degree or relevant work experience. This is the ideal qualification to help you change your career. You'll study 16 units (2 years full-time).

Some master degrees allow you to exit early with a graduate certificate or graduate diploma.



Conduct market research using biometric methods, including access to mobile devices capable of tracking consumers' cognitive, attitudinal and behavioural responses in real-time.



Fees

Tuition fees

Tuition fees are calculated on a semester basis, with indicative course fees for the 2023 commencement year available online.

Student Services and Amenities Fee

The Student Services and Amenities Fee (SSAF) is used for supporting a comprehensive range of non-academic services and amenities. At the time of print (2022) the SSAF is \$315 per year for full-time students. It is charged to most domestic students in addition to tuition fees.

SSAF does not apply to international students.

Scholarships

You may be eligible for a scholarship to support your study. Sign up to the scholarships email alert to make sure you don't miss an opportunity.

Financial assistance

If you're concerned about the cost of postgraduate study, there are several options for financial assistance you can explore.

FEE-HELP

If you are an Australian citizen or a New Zealand Special Category Visa holder or a permanent humanitarian visa, you may be eligible for the Australian Government's FEE-HELP loan for all or part of your tuition fees.

Employer-paid study

Your employer may help you with the cost of postgraduate study. Many organisations have employee-education policies designed to share the costs of education that is mutually beneficial.

If there is a direct connection between your postgraduate course and your current employment, you may be entitled to an income tax deduction for tuition fees and expenses.

Applying to Curtin



Domestic applicants

You're a domestic applicant if:

- · you are an Australian citizen, Australian dual citizen or New Zealand citizen, or
- you are a permanent resident of Australia, or
- · you hold an Australian permanent humanitarian visa.

If any of these points describe you, apply at curtin.edu/pg-apply

International applicants

You're an international applicant if:

- you are not a permanent resident of Australia and New Zealand, or
- you are required to hold a student visa to study in

If either of these points describes you, apply at curtin.edu/int-apply

Credit toward the completion of your degree

You may have undertaken previous study or work experience that matches the knowledge required for some of your Curtin course units. If so, we encourage you to also apply for credit, sometimes called credit for prior learning or advanced standing, which exempts you from having to study certain course units. If you're eligible for credit, you could finish your degree in a shorter amount of time.

English language proficiency

You may need to provide separate evidence of your proficiency in the English language.

Some courses have specific English requirements or require a higher score in an approved English language proficiency test. Specific English requirements can be found within the admission criteria section of each individual course at study.curtin.edu.au.

You can demonstrate your English skills through recognised tests and qualifications, including the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Test of English as a Foreign language (TOEFL) and through qualifications in English.

Proficiency in English can be demonstrated through test results such as IELTS. If you don't meet the required level of English, consider taking our free 10-week English language program at Curtin English, which is available to all international students with an offer to study at Curtin. You can package your English program with your chosen course to streamline your enrolment and visa application process.
